#### **Small Grant Awards**

Restricted to expenses for equipment, supplies, and travel.

This program provides up to \$400 (\$600 for student teams) to assist students in carrying out their research and creative activities during the academic year. The award is designed to help defray the cost of travel, supplies, and other materials to conduct the project. It is not intended as salary for the student.

# Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowships (USRF)

This **program** supports full-time advanced research and creative activities for upper-division students each summer. Each fellowship provides a student stipend and additional support for supplies and/or equipment for the project.

### **Undergraduate Travel Program**

This program provides partial support for students to attend professional meetings and conferences to give a presentation or performance. The student must be the presenting author on the abstract or artist statement. Faculty mentors may also receive support to accompany the student.

26th Annual Student Research and Creativity Conference (SRCC) SRCC 2024 Friday, May 3 3:00-6:00pm

This **program** provides both undergraduate and graduate students an opportunity to present research, creative, and applied learning activities in a student-friendly environment. A variety of presentation formats are accepted: performances, gallery exhibits, video, posters, and oral presentations. Individual, small group and class projects are welcomed. Abstracts must be submitted through the **SRCC website**.

### Faculty Development Opportunities

#### Integration of Undergraduate Research into the Curriculum

Availability subject to budget restrictions in 2023-2024.

Two tracks available: Full Proposals and Supplements to Existing Awards
This program supports the development of new courses and/or the revision of
existing courses to include a substantial undergraduate research component.
Awards of between \$750 and \$1000 may be made to support faculty. This program
is not intended to support minor revisions to seminar courses that already have a
research requirement. Lower-level and upper-level courses are eligible.
Supplements to existing awards are between \$350 and \$500.

### Early Undergraduate Research Opportunity Program (EURO)

**EURO** is intended to provide Buffalo State students with an early undergraduate research/scholarly/creative experience. Recruited students support the faculty member's research/scholarly/creative activities. The program strives to broaden participation in research and to support Buffao State's efforts to engage early-career students and increase retention, especially of those who have demonstrated strong performance in their coursework at BSU. Students must have completed at least 12 credits and no more than 60 credits of coursework at Buffalo State by the time of application.

**Fall Deadline** (10-week or 5-week "micro" projects): September 27, 2023 **Spring Deadline** (10-week or 5-week "micro" projects): February 21, 2024
