Student Opportunities

Small Grants to Support Research, Scholarly and Creative Activities

This **program** provides up to \$400 to assist students in carrying out their research and creative activities during the academic year; for single projects involving 2 or more students the budget may be increased to \$600. The award is designed to help defray the cost of travel, supplies, and other materials to conduct the project. It is not intended as salary for the student.

Undergraduate Travel Program

This **program** provides partial support for students to attend professional meetings and conferences to give a presentation or performance. Eligibility requirements require that the student must be the first author on the abstract or artist statement. As funds are available, faculty mentors may also receive some travel support to accompany the student to the meeting.

Deadline for submitting applications: Open

20th Annual Student Research and Creativity Conference (SRCC) - May 4 & 5, 2018

*Open to both undergraduate & graduate students. This **program** provides students an opportunity to present preliminary and completed research and creative activities in a student-friendly and supportive environment. A variety of presentation formats are accepted: theatrical and musical performances, gallery exhibits, posters, talks, and demonstrations. Individual, small group and class projects are welcome and encouraged.

Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowship

This **program** supports eight weeks of full-time research and creative activities. For summer 2018 we anticipate awarding 26 fellowships. Each fellowship provides a student stipend of \$3000, a faculty stipend of \$1000, and up to \$500 for travel, supplies, and/or equipment to support the project.

Faculty Development Opportunities

Integration of Undergraduate Research into the Curriculum

Two tracks available: Full Proposals and Supplements to Existing Awards
This **program** supports the development of new courses and/or the revision of existing courses to include a substantial undergraduate research component. Awards of between \$750 and \$1000 will be made to support faculty during the summer 2018. This program is not intended to support minor revisions to seminar courses that already have a research requirement. Lower-level and upper-level courses are eligible. Supplements to existing awards are between \$350 and \$500.

Deadline for Full Proposals: May 16, 2018

Deadline for Supplements: Open

Early Undergraduate Research Opportunity Program (EURO)

This **program** is intended to provide Buffalo State students with an early undergraduate research/scholarly/creative experience by serving as an assistant. Recruited students would support the faculty member's research/scholarly/creative activities.

This program strives to broaden participation and support the college's efforts to engage early-career students and increase retention, especially of those who have demonstrated strong performance in their coursework at Buffalo State.

Application site open: November 1, 2017

Applications will be accepted until all available funds are allocated.
